A Non-Rinseable product Sanisol is non-acidic and biodegradable and is blended with anti-bacterial agent to improve germ killing power.

Directions for use :

General Cleaning: Use 1 cup (100mL) of product in a bucket of water (5Ltrs).

Surface Cleaning: Dilute to 1 part product in 20 parts water in a spray bottle or bucket.

For heavy soiling dilute 1 part product to 10 parts water. Remove all food or produce from the area before cleaning.

Apply to surfaces evenly using a mop, scrubbing brush or cloth to wash surfaces. Leave solution on surface for 2 minutes and mop up. Do not rinse.

Safety Precautions :

Due to its strong pine odour, Sanisol is not recommended for use in areas where food is stored, prepared or served.

Use product with adequate ventilation .

Slippery when spilled.

First Aid measures :

Inhalation: Remove victim from exposure . Remove contaminated clothing and loosen remaining clothing.

Remove patient to fresh air. Seek medical advice if effects persist.

Skin Contact: If skin contact occurs, immediately remove contaminated clothing and flush skin with running water.

Eye contact: Keep eyelids open and flush with copious amount of water for 15 minutes. Remove clothing if contaminated and wash skin. Urgently seek medical assistance.

Ingestion: Rinse mouth with water. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Give a glass of water to drink. Never give anything by the mouth to an unconscious patient. If vomiting occurs give further water. Seek urgent medical.

Storage:

Screw on cap tightly after use.

Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place, out of direct sunlight.

Store away from sources of heat or ignition. Sanisol contains terpenes that are flammable.

Shelf life : 2 years from the date of manufacture.

Packing : 500 ml , 1 ltr , 5 Ltrs and 25 Ltrs
