



Chlorine Neutraliser for Professional Laundry

Ultra Antichlor is an rinse additive for eliminating chlorine carry over in commercial laundry applications. Ultra Antichlor is used in the last rinse of the wash process to neutralize all the chemical residues in fabrics. It reduces the fabric damage caused by residual chlorine bleach used in laundering. Ultra Anti-Chlor is also a reducing bleach that works well with stains that are unaffected by chlorine bleach and would need reducing bleaches to remove viz medicinal stains like lodine, Betadine etc.

Salient features:

Stable solution of inorganic reducing agents.

Fully neutralize and de-odourise the chlorine residues.

Decrease potential risk of skin irritation from clothes.

Helps to prevent yellowing of fabric.

Helps to avoid fabric damage on ironer or in tumble dryers.

Specification:

Appearance : Colourless liquid

Odour : Mild pH : 9 - 10 Sp.Gravity : 1.12 Foaming : Low

Stability : 20 – 40 Deg Celcius

Directions for use:

Shake well before use. Add Ultra Anti-Chlor: 30 to 60 ml per 25 Kg.load to a post bleach rinse to neutralize residual chlorine levels. Higher levels of chlorine may warrant increased use of Ultra Anti-Chlor.



Pre Soaking Iodine stains: Add 60-90 ml Ultra Anti-Chlor per 25 kg load to the initial flush to remove Iodine and Betadine stains.

Pre Spotting: To remove Iodine and Betadine stains. Dilute 1:10 to use as a Betadine Spotter. Rub on manual pressure to loosen the fabric deniers. Allow the solution to remain on fabric for 30 minutes prior to laundering.

Safety precautions

Ultra Anti-Chlor should not be allowed to dry on fabric. This may lead to fiber damage of the fabric. Do not mix with other chemicals .

Do not use hot water. Avoid extremes of temperature and direct sunlight. Thermal decomposition can lead to release of toxic or corrosive gases and vapors.

First Aid Measures:

Inhalation: Remove person to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Inhalation of vapours or mist may cause respiratory irritation. Call a doctor if the person feels unwell. Skin Contact: Wash with soap and copious amount of water. If skin irritation occurs, get medical attention.

Eye Contact: Rinse cautiously with water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical attention.

Ingestion:Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If potentially dangerous volume of this material have been swallowed get emergency medical attention.

Storage:

Screw on cap tightly, immediately after use.

Store in a cool, dry and well ventilated area away from direct sunlight.

Do not store near strong oxidizing agents and acids.

Keep out of reach of children.

Packing: 1Ltr, 5Ltrs and 20 Ltrs

Shelf Life: 1 Year from the date of manufacture.
