Limonene is a dish wash concentrate that dissolves heavy grease and soil. Limonene takes its name from citrus fruits. It is a major component in the peel of oranges and is an excellent natural grease removing solvent. Limonene also have anti fungal and antibacterial properties. To stand up to the most difficult cleaning tasks, we have simplified this formulation that reduces the use of surfactants and harsh raw materials like hydrocarbon solvents. Conversely we have increased the use of natural solvents that provide efficiency, cleansing power and fewer environmental issues. The natural solvent Limonene blended with surfactants work as an effective disinfectant surface cleaner for ware washing at homes. It is a hand dish-wash concentrate that has a pleasant citrus odor. Limonene is added with emollients to keep hands soft and supple.

Directions for use :

Manual Wash : Scrap the dishes of excess food and stack the dishes in preparation for washing. If stuck-on- food on plates or vessels, soak for 10 minutes. (Aluminium vessels should not be soaked). Squirt few drops of Limonene directly onto a sponge or the dirty dish. Start with lightly soiled items to heavy ones. Wash one item at a time. Bring them out of the water to check for spots. Wash and rinse thoroughly with clean water and allow to air dry before storing or reusing.

Sink or Dishpan wash : Dilute 50 ml of Limonene for every twenty litres of warm water in the dishwashing sink or pan. Increase the concentration by 2 times for overly high levels of grease and food soil. Soak dishes in the pan or sink. Allow them a bit of soaking time before washing them. Wash plates, bowls, and serving dishes gently with a sponge or scrubber. Replace the wash water when it becomes greasy or if the suds disappear. Rinse with clean water and allow to air dry or wipe dry with a clean towel before storing or reusing.

Washing tips :

Depending on immersion time and skin sensitivity, a safe temperature is in the range of 30 to 50 Degree Celsius. It should be sensibly hot but not scalding.

Cookware or utensils and other surfaces subject to direct contact with food are to be thoroughly washed with Limonene and rinsed with potable water. You can choose to wash dishes and cookware after each meal.

Unless otherwise specified by the manufacturer, you can wash the following materials with Limonene:

- aluminum utensils
- cast iron
- china (hand painted or antique)
- crystal
- cutlery
- decorated glassware
- milk glass
- plastics
- silver
- wooden items

Safety precautions:

Limonene is stable under normal storage and usage conditions and is generally non-reactive. As a precaution, never mix this product with other chemicals. Mix this product only with water.

Contains limonene, a solvent. Do not keep this material near ignition sources.

First aid measures

Inhalation: No specific response required. Move person to fresh air.

Eye Contact: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Call a doctor for treatment if irritation persists.

Skin Contact: Rinse with water. Wash contaminated clothing and shoes before reuse.

Ingestion: Rinse out mouth. Do not induce vomiting. If potentially dangerous volume of this material is consumed, get emergency medical help.

Storage :

Screw on cap tightly after use in original container.

Store in a cool dry place and away from direct sunlight.

Store out of reach of children
